

## Net Zero Commitment Announcement

### Sri Trang Gloves (Thailand) Public Company Limited

Greenhouse gas emissions are a primary driver of climate change, which has led to droughts, floods, and various natural disasters. These events pose significant risks to both global livelihoods and business operations. Moreover, greenhouse gas reduction is one of the key Material Topic for our organization. Setting a Net Zero target reflects our intention and strong commitment to being part of the global effort to address the climate crisis and to support the goal of limiting global temperature rise to no more than 1.5 degrees Celsius, in alignment with the Paris Agreement.

Sri Trang Gloves (Thailand) Public Company Limited (STGT) has therefore established two climate targets one short-term and one long-term—as the foundation for effective and tangible greenhouse gas management planning:

- To reduce greenhouse gas emissions intensity per unit of product by 20% from 2024 baseline by 2030.
- To achieve Net Zero emissions by 2050.


These targets have been communicated across the organization, and all employees are encouraged to take part in ongoing efforts to reduce emissions. Together, we will develop an implementation roadmap that aligns with both our business context and the scientific principles set forth by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi). Our targets cover; Scope 1 Direct emissions from company activities and Scope 2 Indirect emissions from electricity consumption.

To achieve these targets, our strategy is built around three key actions:

1. Enhance – Improve energy efficiency and optimize operational processes to increase productivity.
2. Shift – Transition toward low-carbon technologies and expand the use of renewable energy sources.
3. Capture – Sequester carbon through rubber plantations, reforestation, and the adoption of carbon capture and storage technologies in our production processes.

We believe that our collective commitment will position STGT as a leader in sustainability and greenhouse gas management, in Thailand and globally driving long-term growth while creating lasting value for investors, society, and the environment.
